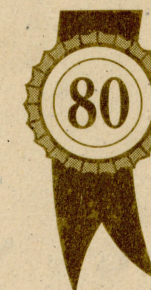

Professor Adam Habib



Professor Adam Habib is an academic, an activist, an administrator, and a renowned political media commentator and columnist.

A professor of Political Science, Habib has more than 30 years of academic, research, institutional and administration expertise. His experience spans five universities and multiple local and international institutions, boards and task teams. His professional involvement in institutions has always been defined by three distinct engagements: the contest of ideas; their translation into actionable initiatives; and the building of institutions.

Professor Habib served as the Deputy Vice-Chancellor for Research, Innovation, Library and Faculty Coordination at the University of Johannesburg (UJ). He also served as the Executive Director at the Human Sciences Research Council, and as a Research Director on Governance and Democracy. Prior to that, he served as a Professor in the School of Development Studies at the University of Natal and as Research Director of the Centre for Civil Society.

He was instrumental in transforming UJ following the nationwide mergers of tertiary institutions in 2005 and played a key role in increasing its research output.

Professor Habib holds qualifications in Political Science from three universities, viz. University of Natal, University of the Witwatersrand and the Graduate School of the City University of New York.

Transformation, democracy and development are fundamental themes of Professor Habib's research. He is well-published and renowned as a key leader in higher education and political studies in South Africa and around the world.

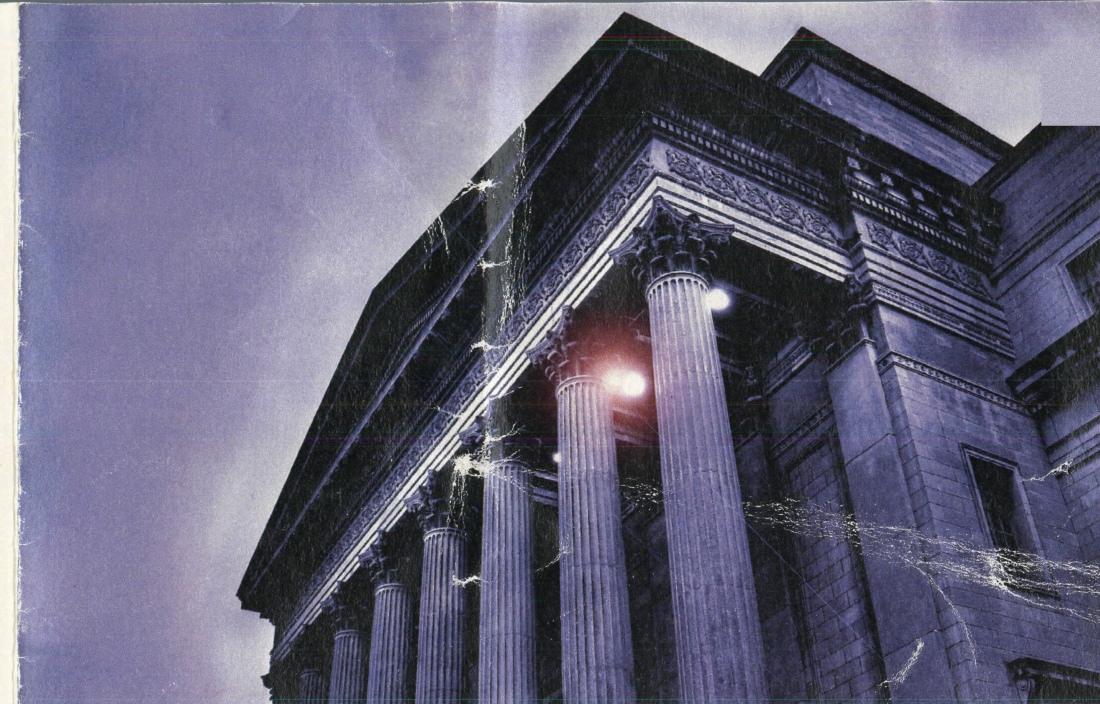
